



Beacon Federal Credit Union Annual Scholarship Award

The Beacon Federal Credit Union College Scholarship Program was established in 2001. The Board of Directors has voted again this year to offer scholarships to selected graduating high school seniors who are members of this credit union. From the applications received this year, a committee appointed by the Board of Directors will select the winners of (3) \$1,500 scholarships, (1) \$500 James H. (Bull) Bounds scholarship and (1) \$500 scholarship in memory of Mr. Danny Silence.

Am I eligible to apply?

Yes, if:

- You open a new, or have an existing Beacon Federal Credit Union Share Savings account with a \$5.00 minimum balance
- You are a graduating high school senior in the 2018-19 school year
- You are planning to attend an accredited two-year or four-year College, University, or Vocational/Technical school in the State of Texas

How do I apply?

Complete the (2) page application and include all required attachments (essay, transcript).

Beacon Federal Credit Union Scholarship Criteria

The Beacon Federal Credit Union is offering college scholarships to the 2018-2019 graduating high school seniors who are members of this credit union and meet the following eligibility requirements:

1. Applicants must be a graduating high school senior, with a minimum of a 2.5 G.P.A., verified by an official transcript.
2. The applicant must be a member in good standing with Beacon FCU.
3. The scholarships will be awarded to applicants who express intent to pursue a course of study that will allow him or her to earn an Associates or Bachelor's degree.
4. The scholarship must be used for the purpose of study at an accredited College, University, or Vocational/Trade school in the State of Texas.
5. Areas of consideration for selection will include need, academic achievement, character, and leadership.
6. If selected as a finalist, the applicant may be required to participate in a personal interview.
7. A committee appointed by the Board of Directors of the credit union will determine the winners.
8. If any of the committee's choices do not accept the scholarships, alternate applicants will be selected.
9. The applicant must submit a typed 250-word essay entitled: How does the credit union philosophy, "People helping People" apply to your life?

Please Note:

The application, essay, and all other required paperwork must be submitted to Beacon Federal Credit Union by **5 pm- Day, March 8, 2019**. Applications will then be reviewed and essays will be judged.
